Owner relinquished; did not want to pay to take Noon on their PCS move

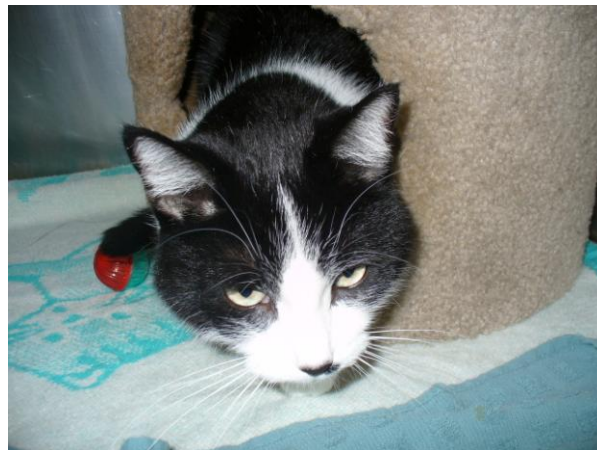
Noon is a very playful, active cat. He loves to play with his toys and meet people. The ideal home for Noon is a family ready to enjoy the company of this lovely adult cat.
