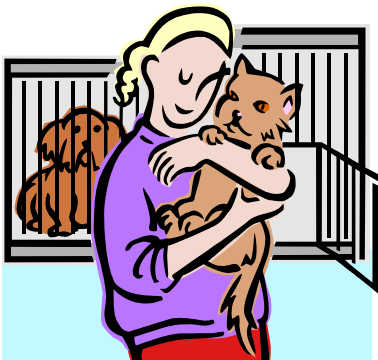


Osan Air Base Animal Shelter (129th Med Det, Veterinary Treatment Facility) Volunteer Program

Who can volunteer?

Volunteers must be 16 years or older

(Children are not allowed in the shelter area unless with their parents and a clinic or shelter staff member viewing animals with the intent to adopt--see adoption fact sheet)

How to volunteer:

Step 1: Come to the Osan VTF, Bldg 766, Mon-Fri, 0900-1200 or 1330-1630 and pick up an application package

Step 2: Complete all information on the Family Support Center Volunteer Data Card and Service Record, AF IMT 2805.

Step 3: Complete all information on the Red Cross Application including the online background clearance procedures.

Step 4: Turn application package into the Red Cross Station Managers Office, Bldg 924, Monday-Friday, 0800-1600. You will be notified by **email** of when the next training class is scheduled.
